

Opportunity for a fellowship in a pediatric academic hospital in the center of Paris, France, for a pediatrician who has graduated in pediatrics in a country of the European Union (1 to 4 years)

We are pleased to offer a fellowship in hospital pediatrics starting in November 2022, for a duration of 1 to 4 years. The Applicant should have his diploma in pediatrics and thesis validated by his local institutions at the time he arrives in Paris.

The Applicant will join the team of Prof Chalumeau in the Department of Pediatrics and Pediatric Infectious Diseases from Necker – Enfants malades Hospital, Assistance Publique – Hôpitaux de Paris, Université Paris Cité, located in the center of Paris. Necker–Enfants malades Hospital is one of the largest pediatric healthcare hospitals in the world, with a total of 400 beds, covering all medical and surgical subspecialties dedicated to child care and including state-of-the-art imaging and laboratory equipment. The Department has 40 beds (50 during the winter epidemics and 37 during the rest of the year).

The Department is dedicated to fostering excellence in pediatrics through clinical care and medical education in various fields of pediatrics, including:

- acute care (patients admitted through the emergency room and the PICU),
- infectious diseases (co-responsibility of the antibiotic stewardship team),
- hemoglobinopathies and red cell disorders (reference center for sickle cell disease),
- infantology (reference center for Pierre-Robin syndrome and other related syndromes),
- child protection.

The team has 8 permanent physicians (hospital practitioners and (associate) professors), and 7 non-permanent pediatricians (registrars, fellows, and physicians working under renewable contracts).

The position is open for someone who has just completed the residency training in Pediatrics or already has a first experience as a fellow or registrar in pediatrics.

The fellowship and specific missions of the Applicant can be organized and tailored according to the Applicant's personal projects and skills.

The Fellow will have to contribute to clinical care continuity in the hospital through weekend shifts in the Department (about 1/month) and night shifts in the PICU or emergency room (about 2/month).

The Fellow will have protected time for his medical education, and there are also several opportunities for participating in clinical and translational research projects.

The Applicant should be sufficiently fluent in French to be able to manage patients and participate in all the activities of the Department but does not have to be perfectly fluent.
